Lifeguard	Responsible for guarding deep and shallow water areas. Will train after arrival. Must assist guests with a smile. Other tasks may be assigned by supervisor as necessary. Requirements: Must be good swimmer. Must be able to swim at least 50 meters. Excellent written and verbal English. Must score minimum 27/32 SLEP listening. Must pass Lifeguard certification and CPR certification exams after arrival.	30 - 60+	Required uniform pieces are free of charge if returned per company policy. Cashier / Tickets	Responsible for greeting and admitting guests into the park, cashiering in arcades, food stands, and tube rentals. Must assist guests with a smile. Other tasks may be assigned by supervisor as necessary. Requirements: Must be familiar with US currency. Must have excellent written and verbal English. Park Services	Responsible for keeping the park looking its best. Must assist guests with a smile. Other tasks may be assigned by supervisor as necessary. Requirements: Must have willingness to clean. Food & Beverage	Preparing or serving food at restaurants, snack bars, and outdoor carts. Must assist guests with a smile. Other tasks may be assigned by supervisor as necessary. Grounds Upkeep	Student will be responsible for grounds upkeep, grass cutting, trimming trees and shrubs, tube repair, garbage pick-up from housing, picnic set up, grilling for outdoor picnics, and Flash Flood operation. Position hours are 7:30am - closing, 6 days per week. Must assist guests with a smile. Other tasks may be assigned by supervisor as necessary. Requirements: Must have willingness to clean. NUMBER OF POSITIONS: 60 - mostly lifeguards.

EMPLOYMENT PERIODS:

Start Date: Lifeguards wanted for earlier start dates. Other positions have flexible start dates.

End Date: September 6, 2009 ONLY. No earlier, no later.

Program Length: Approximately 3-4 months.

BONUS INCENTIVES: The above listed positions include an end of contract bonus if hired. Upon successful completion of the program period, \$.50 per hour worked from May 29 - September 6 will be given.

OVERTIME RATE/TERMS: Employer exempt from overtime pay. No Overtime pay available.

HOUSING: Housing is very basic. Modest houses, motel rooms or rustic cabin units shared by Noah's Ark employees are approx. \$240 per month, per person. A \$100 non-refundable administration fee is deducted from payroll. Housing is within walking or biking distance from the employer. Housing is assigned to students "first come-first serve", meaning students with late June/July arrival dates will probably have more rustic housing. Some basic kitchenware may be available, but varies by housing facility. Students are allowed to identify their own non- Noah's Ark housing and move out at any time. The only penalty for move out is loss of non-refundable administration fee that goes towards the cleaning of the housing. Students are only allowed to remain in housing during employment period. Participants must vacate housing before or on September 7
